KUNAI for iPhone contains the following features for the purpose of improvement and advancement the Software;

- (a) sending the status of use of the Software periodically,
- (b) sending the log file when the Software crash.

Cybozu group may use the information of the Customer related to use the Software to the extent necessary to collect and analyze the situation etc..In addition, Cybozu uses the software and services provided by a third party to collect the said information, the said information is transmitted to the third party. Cybozu and the said third party shall not collect the information which can identify the Customer or the Customer's device.

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▼Cybozu policy regarding handling of the transmitted information as specified below explains what information is collected and how the information is used by Cybozu.

- (1) The transmitted information about the status of use is:

- (a)type and version of the Customer's OS
- (b)type of the device,
- (c)version of KUNAI
- (d)connection method, type and version of the Target Software
- (e)certification method
- (f)the status of use of functions of the Software

The transmitted information contains terminal identification information(not terminal identification number) which is generated randomly.

Cybozu use the software and services provided by third parties to collect the said information.

▼The service agreement as specified below shall be applied to handling of the information collected by the third parties.

- (2) The transmitted information of crash log is:

- (a)crash log
- (b)type and version of the device,
- (c)connection method of KUNAI
- (d)the status of use of Cybozu Live

Cybozu use the software and services of the Firebase to collect crash log. The information is transmitted to the Firebase after checking each time whether to transmit to the Customers. The Firebase may collect the information, such as type and version of the OS and the device, etc. of the Customer periodically.
